ADDIE DADDIO is the Founder & Director of The Daddio Collective a 501c (3) Charity organization that effects change in the lives of people, animals and communities through their initiatives Love that Dog Hollywood, Mission for Love & Creativity for a Cause.

Love that Dog Hollywood, their animal rescue initiative, works to save animals lives, educate people, host school programs, assist with spay/neuter along with an outreach to homeless pets. They rescued, rehabbed and rehomed 300 plus animals in 2014.

Approximately 65% of the animals rescued are from high kill shelters in Los Angeles City & County along with animals from San

They create tailored opportunities that empower young people to change the world they live in. Some of the causes include fresh water to Africa, animals, animal rights, opportunities for women in third world nations. They work with amazing young people who are creating change in the world we live in.
